They drew a shape of a cow to represent a cow, a shape of a sheep for a sheep, and so on. It was a good way to present real things, but it could not show some words such as "sorrow," "old," or "eat."

Later, Sumerians began to combine pictures to show (B). For example, an eye with tears might be used to stand for "sorrow". Similarly, a face with wrinkles might be used to stand for "old." But the biggest problem with this system was that pictures might be misunderstood by different people.

To solve this problem, the pictures were changed into marks that were easier to write. These marks were finally developed into (C), symbols showing the smallest unit of meaningful sounds. It was the beginning of modern writing based on sounds.
