1. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, Kairnsville High School students. This is Vice Principal Hudson. As you know, last week we asked students to vote for a name for the new student lounge. Well, we've collected all the votes, and we finally have the result. So, I'd like to take this time to announce the name of the student lounge, which is Deep Breath Station. This name received more than 70% of the votes. Once again, I'm happy to announce that the name of the student lounge, based on your votes, is Deep Breath Station. Instead, if you shorten your steps, your body is placed in a natural forward-moving position, which decreases the amount of force coming down on your joints. So, to lower the chance of injury when you run, shortening your steps may be the answer. That's all for this video, and I'll see you in the next one.

W: Good afternoon, students. Dogs are known to be loyal pets, but they're capable of much more. So today, we'll learn about rare jobs that dogs do around the world. First, there are dogs in France that find valuable mushrooms called truffles. Their sharp sense of smell allows them to locate the truffles precisely, which saves people time and effort to harvest them. Second, on an island in southern Australia, there's a type of sheepdog that protects the penguin population. These dogs guard the shores where the penguins live to keep them safe from foxes. Next, winemakers in Chile use dogs in wine storage facilities for quality control. The dogs smell the wine barrels to detect if any are spoiled or contain harmful elements. Finally, Italy has specially trained dogs that act as lifeguards for its most popular beaches. These dogs pull drowning people to safety and even jump out of helicopters to rescue people in the water. Now, let's watch a video showing these dogs in action.
